ASH WEDNESDAY

Scripture: Hebrews 12:1-14, Luke 18:9-14

Memory verse: Hebrews 12:12-14

“Therefore strengthen your feeble arms and weak knees. ‘Make level paths for your feet,’ so that the lame may not be disabled, but rather healed. Make every effort to live in peace with everyone and be holy; without holiness no one will see the Lord.” (Hebrews 12:12-14)

FIRST SUNDAY IN LENT

Scripture: John 12:44-50, Hebrews 2:10-18

Memory verse: John 12:44-46

“Then Jesus cried out, “Whoever believes in me does not believe in me only, but in the one who sent me. The one who looks at me is seeing the one who sent me. I have come into the world as a light, so that no one who believes in me should stay in darkness.”

SECOND SUNDAY IN LENT

Scripture: John 8:19-24

Memory verse: John 8:24

“Very truly I tell you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be judged but has crossed over from death to life.

THIRD SUNDAY IN LENT

Scripture: John 8:25-29, Psalm 34

Memory verse: Psalm 34:8

“Taste and see that the Lord is good, blessed is the one who takes refuge in him.”

FOURTH SUNDAY IN LENT

Scripture: John 6:27-40, Psalm 19

Memory verse: Psalm 19:14

“May words of my mouth and this meditation of my heart be pleasing in your sight, Lord, my Rock and my Redeemer.”

FIFTH SUNDAY IN LENT

Scripture: John 8:46-59, Psalm 118

Memory verse: Romans 12:1-2

“Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God’s mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. 2 Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God’s will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.”

PALM SUNDAY

Scripture: Luke 19:41-48, Psalm 103

Memory Verse: Psalm 103:8

“The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in love.”

MAUNDY THURSDAY

Scripture: Mark 14:12-25, 1 Corinthians 10:14-17

Memory Verse: John 15:12

“My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you.”

GOOD FRIDAY

Scripture: John 19:38-42

Memory Verse: Psalm 22:3-5

“Yet you are enthroned as the Holy One; you are the one Israel praises. In you our ancestors placed their trust; they trusted and you delivered them. To you they cried out and were saved; in you they trusted and were not put to shame.”

EASTER

Scripture: John 20:19-23; Psalm 150

Memory Verse: John 20:21
